- 1. Understand the purpose and Planned values of our ministry. Take a look at the values and goals that make our youth ministry effective in reaching and caring for students.
- 2. Commit to a Program. Consider the role in which God has shaped you in order to build relationships with students.
- 3. Grow as a minister. Develop your personal ministry, which will ultimately influence students.
- 4. Understand the Purpose and planned values of our ministry.

Why You?

PURPOSE STATEMENT

Our youth ministry exists to reach non-believing students, to connect them with other Christians, to help them grow in their faith and discover their ministry and honor God with their life.

PLANNED VALUES

Planned values are descriptive words that reflect our values, attitudes, styles, and beliefs that "Influence" our purpose. We try to incorporate these key elements into our programs and our lives. It is all built on RELATIONSHIPS.

COMMIT TO A PROGRAM

Commitment Option #1: Weekly Middle School Service, Wednesdays 7:00 - 8:30 PM. This is our large group meeting that is designed to have a friendly, fun, challenging, and exciting atmosphere. This program shatters the "church is boring" stereotype and helps students celebrate life. It is filled with laughter, antics, videos, singing, and a message that moves students towards spiritual maturity.

Volunteer Role: We need adults to greet, learn names, talk to students, encourage students to attend other programs, and help create an exciting atmosphere.

Commitment Option #2: Bible Study Small Groups, Sundays 9:00 - 10:30 AM. This program is key in making our big group small. We meet as a larger group and introduce the topic involving multimedia and some teaching then we break up into small groups for interaction where the adult leaders facilitate discussion and asks a lot of questions to guide the group. This is a powerful time for students who are being cared for, prayed for, and held accountable by their small group.

Volunteer Role: This is a great place to start with students. This is your opportunity to go deeper with a group of students you can care for, encourage, pray with, and follow up on during the week.

Program Option #3: Ministry Teams/Special Events (Meeting times vary) Ministry teams are filled with students who are involved in an area of ministry based on their desires and gifts. We'd love to have all of our students committed to having a ministry where they serve God. Examples of these teams include drama, music, greeting, creative team, special events, media, snack shack, the options are really limitless and the ministry experience is invaluable.

Volunteer Role: Ministry Team Coordinator/Overseer Oversee the organizing and implementation of one of the several ministries. Most teams need to function with an adult leader walking along side for coaching, strategy, and encouragement. Students will need training in specific areas and scheduled on a rotation.

There are many other opportunities to get involved in our ministry and entrepreneurial or original ideas are considered according to our resources and the five purposes of the church.

Background check: All volunteers must undergo a mandatory criminal background check when working with minors. This information will be kept private.

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BACKGROUND CHECK AUTHORIZATION
