A HIGHER WAY TO PRAY

Rather than praying for his supernatural deliverance, Paul prays for the Philippians' spiritual vitality:

- A GROWING LOVE ever-increasing in capacity.
- A KHOWING LOVE rooted in Biblical truth (over human emotion).
- A DISCERNING LOVE applying Biblical knowledge precisely and consistently.

A HIGHER WAY TO PRAY

"God, get me outta here!"

"God use this for my purity (v.10) that will result in your praise" (v.11).

THE RECIPE FOR JOY

"I want you to know that what has happened to me has really served to advance the gospel.

Paul's strategy was to go to Rome as a preacher.

He went instead as a prisoner

A GOSPEL ADVANCE

Advance: prokope

Paul saw his imprisonment not as a detour, but as a doorway. Every detour in life is really a COOF to a new opportunity I otherwise would have missed.

"I am suffering even to the point of being chained like a criminal. But God's word is not chained." 2 TIHBTHY 219

CHAINS THAT FREE

Paul's chains freed him to preach to the Roman soldiers.

"As a result, it has become clear throughout **the whole palace** guard and to everyone else that I am in chains for Christ."

CHAINS THAT FREE

Paul's chains freed him to preach in Caesar's court.

"All God's people send you greetings, especially those who belong to C**aesar's household**."

CHAINS THAT FREE 3 Paul's chains freed him to embolden believers.

"Because of my chains, most of **the believers have become confident** in the Lord and dare all the more to proclaim the gospel without fear."

HOW TO REPURPOSE CHAINS

STEP 1

Identify the chains in my life right now:

Physical limitations, financial challenges, a hard marriage, singleness, hostile work environment, etc.

HOW TO REPURPOSE CHAINS

STEP 2

Thank God for each chain.

"My God, I have never thanked Thee for my thorns. I have thanked Thee a thousand times for my roses, but not once for my thorns. I have been looking forward to a world where I shall get compensation for my cross: but I have never thought of my cross as itself a present glory. Teach me the glory of my cross: teach me the value of my thorn. Show me that I have climbed to Thee by the path of pain. Show me that my tears have made my rainbow."
