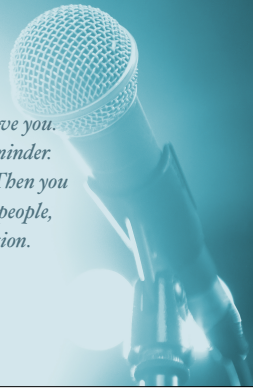
Be LOYAL

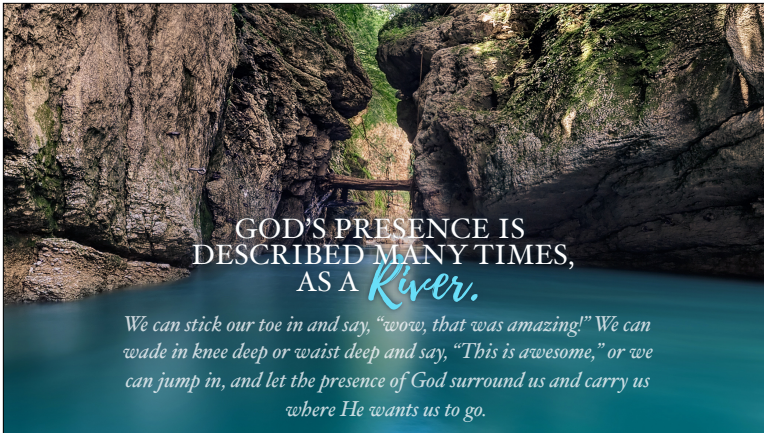
THE PURPOSE OF
