And he said, "With what can we compare the kingdom of God, or what parable shall we use for it?

#### MARK 4:26-34

"It is like a grain of mustard seed, which, when sown on the ground, is the smallest of all the seeds on earth, yet when it is sown it grows up and becomes larger than all the garden plants and puts out large branches, so that the birds of the air can make nests in its shade." With many such parables he spoke the word to them, as they were able to hear it. He did not speak to them without a parable, but privately to his own disciples he explained everything.

1.6 billion people on earth, 40 million born again Christians. Ratio of 40 to 1.

1950

2.5 billion people on earth, 80 million born again Christians. Ratio of 30 to 1.

1980

4.5 billion people on earth, 275 million born again Christians. Ratio of 15 to 1.

1990


5.2 billion people on earth, 500 million born again Christians. Ratio 9 to 1.

2010

6.9 billion people on earth, 800 million born again Christians. Ration of 8.5 to 1.

In Asia, Christianity is **growing more than twice as fast** as the general
population, most through conversions.
Asia has seen **the number of Christians double from 1970 to 2010**.
