


### 2 PETER 1:12-15


## WHAT What preachers do: Remind us of truth we already know.

"Teach others these great truths you have heard me preach. Teach them to trustworthy people who will, in turn, pass them on to others."


3-M MODEL for Sustainability and Reproduction:

### 2 PETER 1:16-21


We didn't follow cleverly invented stories when we told you about the power and coming of our Lord, but we were eyewitnesses of his majesty. <sup>17</sup> For he received honor and glory from God when the Father's own glorious voice said, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased." <sup>18</sup> We ourselves heard this voice from heaven when we were with him on the sacred mountain.

### 2 PETER 1:16-21

<sup>19</sup> So we have the word of the prophets made more certain, and you will do well to pay attention to it, as to a light shining in a dark place, until the day dawns and the morning star rises in your hearts.
