- It was famous for its influential Jewish community




#### SMYRNA THE CHURCH

- It was a little church in big trouble.
- It was a church of extremes: poor yet rich, persecuted yet protected.
- It was a church that was known by Jesus: "I know..." (v. 9)



## SMYRNA A Church of EXTREMES The extreme of distress: "I know your afflictions" VS 9 AFFLICTION: oppressive weight, crushing stress

# SMYRNA A Church of EXTREMES The extreme of destitution: "I know your poverty" VS 9 POVERTY: beggary, absolute and utter destitution



**SLANDEROUS ACCUSATIONS:** cannibalism, atheism and perversion.

## SYNAGOGUE Literally, the assembly of God.

Synagogue of Satan: Those who profess to be God's people but who take on and promote the values of the world.

The Promise of GROWTH:
"You will be put into prison to test you." VS 10

**HARDSHIP** reveals how much we have grown and how much we can endure.





## The Promise of PURPOSE: "You will suffer persecution for ten days." vs 10

**HARDSHIP** is always limited by God's sovereign purpose.

## Promises. in Persecution



### The Promise of VICTORY:

Be faithful, even unto death, and I will give you the crown of life." vs 10

The "CROWN OF LIFE" is a Divine guarantee of forever.
