"To the angel of the church in Thyatira write: These are the words of the Son of God, whose eyes are like blazing fire and whose feet are like burnished bronze. 19 I know your deeds—your love and faith, your service and perseverance—and that you are now doing more than you did at first. 20 Nevertheless, I have this against you: You tolerate that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess. By her teaching she misleads my servants into sexual immorality and the eating of food sacrificed to idols.


²¹ I have given her time to repent of her immorality, but she is unwilling. ²² So I will cast her on a bed of suffering, and I will make those who commit adultery with her suffer intensely, unless they repent of her ways. ²³ I will strike her followers dead. Then all the churches will know that I am he who searches hearts and minds, and I will repay each of you according to your deeds.

²⁴ I say to the rest of you, who do not hold this teaching, who haven't known the deep things of Satan—as they say —I do not put any other burden on you.: ²⁵ Only hold on to what you have until I come. ²⁶ To him who overcomes and does my will to the end, I will give authority over the nations—²⁷ 'He will rule them with an iron scepter; he will dash them to pieces like pottery'— just as I have received authority from my Father. ²⁸ I will also give him the morning star. ²⁹ He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.

The least known and least influential church of the seven churches in Asia minor.



THYATIRA THE CITY

Militarily expendable, politically insignificant, culturally irrelevant

THYATIRA WHY A LETTER?

To encourage both believers and pastors living in small cities, serving insignificant churches

To warn churches of the consequence of tolerating moral compromise in its midst.

THYATIRA THE EXALTED AUTHOR

The Son of God with flaming eyes: *penetrating awareness*

The Son of God with polished brass feet: *incomparable strength*

Jesus is unequivocally asserting his <u>deity</u> and <u>authority</u> as Lord over his church

THE MODEL LEADER

Jesus is modeling how good leaders lead
—pastors, parents, bosses, mentors:

A church is guilty by association if it does not confront a Jezebel spirit in its midst.
