vs 15 "If you love me, obey my commands."


"Those who accept and obey my commands are the ones who love me."



THE FACT THAT LOVE CALLS FOR **proof** IN NO WAY DIMINISHES THE DOCTRINE OF UNCONDITIONAL LOVE. It merely clarifies what "unconditional" means.

To love *unconditionally* means the love we have and express toward another is not dependent upon their worth or the work. Rather, that love flows from the core of our being.
