



# Word used for: a person called in when a company of soldiers were depressed and discouraged to put new courage into their minds and hearts. Always someone called in to help in time of trouble or need.




### JOHN 14:27 (AMPLIFIED BIBLE VERSION)

### FOUR POSSIBLE RESPONSES

## We could **CONFORM**

We start compromising what we believe and the way we act in order to appeal to and appease the surrounding culture.

MATTHEW 16:24

"Then Jesus said to his disciples, "Whoever wants to be my disciple must deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me."

### FOUR POSSIBLE RESPONSES

### We could CHECK OUT

The opposite extreme is to secede from culture, distancing ourselves so completely that we never have any interaction with the world around us.

JOHN 17:15-16

"My prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that you protect them from the evil one. They are not of the world, even as I am not of it."

### FOUR POSSIBLE RESPONSES

### We could **COMBAT**

The problem with this approach is that it's antagonistic and defensive and it misses the heart of Jesus.

JOHN 18:36

Jesus said, "My kingdom is not of this world. If it were, my servants would fight to prevent my arrest by the Jewish leaders. But now my kingdom is from another place."

# We could COUNTER We stand firmly on the truth of God, empowered by the Spirit, to extend the love of Christ to a lost and dying world.
