A THEOLOGICAL DISTINCTION

Although abiding in Christ is a choice we make, it first was a choice God made.

"You didn't choose me, but I chose you and appointed you so that you might go and bear fruit fruit that will last—so that whatever you ask in my name the Father will give you." JOHN 15:16

THE MYSTICAL UNION OF THE BELIEVER WITH CHRIST

This union—the *unio mystica*—is effected mysteriously and supernaturally by the Holy Spirit, whereby believers, individually and corporately, are fundamentally connected with the Lord Jesus Christ for time and eternity.



AN EXPECTED OUTCOME

<u>There will be fruit</u> from our union with Christ.

"If you abide in me and I in you, you will bear fruit." JOHN 15:5

> "If you abide in me, you will bear much fruit." JOHN 15:5

"You will bear fruit—fruit that will remain." JOHN 15:16

AN EXPECTED **OUTCOME**

Copious fruitfulness is Christ's expectation for every believer: *"much fruit."* **v5**

Copious fruitfulness is God-pleasing worship: "this is to my Father's glory." **v8a**

Copious fruitfulness is compelling proof of Christian discipleship: *"showing yourselves to be my disciples."* **v8b**

Copious fruitfulness is a sure pathway to personal joy: "I've told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete." **v11**

the westminster CONFESSION

"We exist to glorify God and to fully enjoy him forever."

God is most glorified in us when we are most joyful in him—and we are most joyful in him when we are bringing him the most glory. God's greatest glory is when we live in this world as fruit-bearing believers.

DEFINING THE FRUIT

We must bear fruit that is internal: **our character.**

'Love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control." GALATIANS 5:22-23



We must bear fruit that is external: **our conduct.**

"My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. Greater love has no one than this: to lay down your life for yours friends." JOHN 15:12-14



We must bear fruit that is eternal: **our converts**.

"And you must testify about me." JOHN 15:27

The greatest fruit, the greatest glory, the greatest love and the greatest joy is simply this:

Using the influence of our lives our words, our actions, our financial investments to expand God's family.

Family can multiply to 476 million in 3 years.



































