

GETTING WHAT YOU NEED—AND WANT





JOHN 15:7-8 & 16






WHY DO WE NEED TO ASK DAILY FOR BREAD? Daily praying jogs our memory that God not only provides answers, he is our answer! The issue is not just about having a full stomach; it is about having a full heart. It is not really bread that we need daily, it is God that we need daily.

"You fathers—if your children ask for a fish, do you give them a snake instead, or a scorpion if they ask for an egg? Never! So if you sinful people know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him?"



WHAT JESUS SAYS ABOUT ASKING #1 Never again think of asking as a selfish imposition; it is a sacred invitation. #2 While asking does produce results, the Divine intent in asking is to nurture relationship.





GARDENING RULES For God's Vineyard 2 Fruitful praying must always be watered by asking in Jesus' name. "Whatever you ask in my name the Father will give you." - John 15:16

PRAYING IN JESUS' NAME Using Jesus name is to ask for what is consistent with his flawless character, in submission to his perfect will and will bring him utmost glory. Using Jesus name correctly means we should pray as if Jesus himself were doing the asking.

THE PROMISE OF PRAYING If, in my asking, I will care for God's glory, God will care for my good. "Delight yourself in the Lord and he will give you the desires of your heart." - Psalm 37:4
