


The Prayer of Jabez: A Smart Selfishness

I CHRONICLES 4:9-10

Jabez was more honorable than his brothers. His mother named him Jabez, saying, "I gave birth to him in pain." Jabez cried out to God, "Oh, that you would bless me and enlarge my territory! Let your hand be with me and keep me from harm so that I will be free from pain." And God granted his request.

The GENESIS of PAIN
Physical → what I was born with
Relational → what was done to me
Self-Inflicted → what I did to myself
Historical \rightarrow what I hold onto

Transformation is God's calling-card; simple prayer is my catalyst!




JABEZ' PAIN

THE ASK

For God's help in his work: "And enlarge my territory."

For God's involvement in his well-being: "Let your hand be with me and keep me from harm."

For God's redemption of his nature: **"So that I will not cause pain."**
