1 SET A **LIMIT** TO **NEGATIVITY**


I must be very selective when entering a significant relationship.

#2 GET AROUND PEOPLE OF **OPTIMISTIC FAITH**

God created me to need **positive input** from **positive people** to counteract pessimism that seeps into my soul from sin.

"AS OIL AND PERFUME MAKE THE HEART GLAD, SO A SWEET FRIENDSHIP REFRESHES THE SOUL." PROVERBS 27:9

THE NEGATIVITY **BIAS**

Negative input exerts much greater impact on my brain than positive input.

The power of negatives increases disproportionately over positives.

In general, at least 2 positives are needed to offset 1 negative; ...in marriage, the ratio is 5:1

NEGATING THE NEGATIVE

I must remember that God is less interested in my negative circumstances than in my positive faith response to them.

"If you do what is right, you'll be blessed. But if you don't do what's right, sin is crouching at your door; it desires to have you. You must rule over it." GENESIS 4:6

We cannot choose how many years we will live, but we can choose how much life those years will have.

> We cannot control the beauty of our face, but we can control the expression on it.

We cannot control life's difficult moments, but we can choose to make life less difficult.

We cannot control the negative atmosphere of the world, but we can control the atmosphere of our minds.

Too often, we choose to control things we cannot. Too seldom, we choose to control what we can: Our response.
