THE GENRE: Proverbs 31 is a poem.

- It is a twenty-two line acrostic using the Hebrew alphabet.
- It personifies "lady wisdom" (cf. Prov. 8:1-11, Msg.)
- It conveys totality by honoring even ordinary achievements in everyday life.

THE INTENT: Proverbs 31 celebrates valor.

 "Virtuous woman" is best translated "woman of valor".


• Eshet Chayil: It celebrates everything done every day in faith and love.
