#### WHAT THE KINGDOM is

Kingdom building *is* about inward adjustments and attitudes.

"The Kingdom of God...is righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit." V. 17B

#### DEFINING **RIGHTEOUSNESS**, **PEACE & JOY** VERTICALLY

"Through the Gospel, the righteousness of God is revealed." ROMANS 1:17

"Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through Jesus." ROMANS 5:1

"May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, so that by the power of the Holy Spirit you may abound in hope." ROMANS 15:13 In Romans 14, righteousness, peace and joy are not meant to be defined vertically much as they are to be applied horizontally.

Our adjustment to the work of God theologically must be reflected in our attitudes toward the people of God relationally.

#### HOW THE KINGDOM is APPLIED

Kingdom building is practically applied by building healthy relationships.
