

GOSSIP: The **Socially** Acceptable Sin

PROVERBS 18:8 (CEV) "There's nothing so delicious as the taste of gossip! It melts in your mouth."

GOSSIP: The **Theologically** Unacceptable Sin

LEVITICUS 19:16 "Do not spread gossip. Do not try to get ahead at the cost of your neighbor's life, for I am the Lord your God."

PSALM 101:5 "Gag the gossip who bad-mouths his neighbor; I can't stand [their] arrogance."

Getting clear about

OLD TESTAMENT: to spread a bad report

NEW TESTAMENT: to whisper

DICTIONARY: idle talk or rumor, especially about the personal or private affairs of others

Getting clear about

IN PRACTICE: to talk about a person, true or not, in a less than flattering way to tear them down, not to build them up

Is it Gossip?

Would I say the same thing if the one I'm talking about were present?

Would I say the same thing about a person if Jesus were there?

WHY GOD DESPISES GOSSIP

Gossip creates conflict.

PROVERBS 16:28 "An evil person sows strife; gossip separates the best of friends."

PROVERBS 6:19 "God hates the gossip who stirs up conflict in the spiritual community."

WHY GOD DESPISES GOSSIP

2 Gossip ruins relationships.

PROVERBS 16:28 "Gossip separates best friends."

WHY GOD DESPISES GOSSIP

Gossip corrodes confidence.

PROVERBS 11:13 "A gossip betrays a confidence, but a trustworthy person keeps a secret."

WHY GOD DESPISES GOSSIP

Gossip razes reputations.

PROVERBS 18:21 "The tongue has the power of life and death."

Once spoken, our-words are irretrievable!

Boys flying kites haul in their white-winged birds; You can't do that when you're flying words... Thoughts, unexpressed, may fall back dead, But God himself can't kill them once they're said.

LOVE THE GOSSIPER ELIMINATE THE GOSSIP

I must redirect the conversation of a gossip.

"Without wood a fire goes out; without gossip a quarrel dies down." **PROVERBS 26:20**

LOVE THE GOSSIPER ELIMINATE THE GOSSIP

I must reprove the person who persists in gossip.

"Better is open rebuke than hidden love." **PROVERBS 27:5**

"The one who rebukes another will in the end gain more favor than the one who has a flattering tongue." **PROVERBS 28:23**

LOVE THE GOSSIPER, ELIMINATE THE GOSSIP

I must remove myself from the chronic gossip's presence.

"A gossip betrays a confidence; so avoid one who talks too much." PROVERBS 20:19

LOVE THE GOSSIPER THE GOSSIP


4 I must regulate my own words.
