ACCESSING SUPERNATURAL RESOURCES

MATTHEW 6:16-18

"When you fast, do not look somber as the hypocrites do, for they disfigure their faces to show others they are fasting. Truly I tell you, they have received their reward in full.

"But when you fast, put oil on your head and wash your face, so that it will not be obvious to others that you are fasting, but only to your Father, who is unseen; and your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.

NOT IF, BUT WHEN... ~ MATTHEW 6:4,6 & 18

When You Give: Your Father...will reward you.

When You Pray: Your Father...will reward you.

When You Fast: Your Father...will reward you.

- Fasting only had spiritual value as it was connected to prayer.
- The only fast commanded in Scripture was connected to the Day of Atonement.

 The normal fast commenced at sunrise and concluded at sunset.

Fasting had three main objectives:

To draw God's attention to the person fasting.
To fast vicariously on behalf of another.
To prove prove genuine penitence.

- Fasting, because it carried such high ideals and great potential, was always vulnerable to misuse.
- God-pleasing fasting was always linked with a pure heart and humble obedience.

"Is not this the kind of fasting I have chosen?" ~ISAIAH 58:6

- The validity of fasting as a sign of atonement ceased when Jesus made the once-for-all sacrifice on the cross. (HEBREWS 10:10)
- Fasting, therefore, is an entirely non-compulsory, voluntary act, not a spiritual duty to be regularly observed.
- Though not compulsory, Jesus assumed we would fast.

IT PRODUCES

Self-Discipline

Though never to stand alone, self-denial and the practice of a spiritual discipline are values of the Kingdom Life; reminders that we belong to Another and are not living to please ourselves.

IT PREVENTS

Earthly Enslavement

God's greatest adversaries are his gifts. Because we drift into worship of the gifts instead of the Giver, fasting forces us to put those gifts back in their proper place.

IT PROMOTES

Spiritual Breakthroughs

Historically, God has been pleased to make prayer and fasting the launching pad for missional endeavors that have changed the course of world history.

IT PROMPTS

Divine Favor

True fasting is born out of and cultivates even greater hunger for God. The richest reward of fasting is no earthly result, but an eternal relationship with God that deepens day-by-day.

The deepest cry of our heart is nothing more than homesickness for God.

Christian fasting is often the first step in the journey toward our Father's house!
