### Being Judged:


The worst part about being judged is you never get to present your side of the story.

# The Golden


Rule



\* "speck": Greek-"kaphos"- a small stalk, twig, or sliver



When I see something in you that bothers me and makes me want to judge you, I need to look in the mirror and quit looking at you.




"You hypocrite, first take the plank out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck from your brother's eye." ~Matthew 7:5
