Pray for the peace of Jerusalem:


"May those who love you be secure.

God created you, has redeemed you as His own and for His purposes, and has provided for you.


COMPELLING REASONS FOR CHURCH ATTENDANCE

HS Corporate Worship INFORMS us


"There the thrones for judgment stand, the thrones of the house of David."

Worship Makes a Difference

Corporate worship doesn't satisfy our need for God's presence; it sharpens it so that it spills over the hour of worship and saturates the week of living with His presence.

Worship Makes a Difference

"Peace..."
Psalm 122:6-8

PEACE: The wholeness and security of being formed, transformed and informed by God's presence.

Worship Makes a Difference "Prosperity..." Psalm 122:9

PROSPERITY: The leisurely attitude of knowing that everything is right because God is over you and always has the final say-so in your life.

Corporate worship is the pause that sharpens the disciple on the long journey in the same direction toward God.
