II Corinthians 9:6

Remember this: Whoever <u>sows</u> <u>sparingly</u> will also reap sparingly, and whoever sows generously will also <u>reap generously</u>.

Faith Promise Principles Principle # 7 Our giving should challenge and stretch us Il Corinthians 8: 1 - 3 The Macedonians gave when they were under a most severe trial They gave out of extremepoverty
